As he worked to rebuild his life, he found strength, motivation and love through the companionship of his dog Marley. Zach was inspired to create an organization dedicated to giving second chances to both dogs and people.



Founded in 2009, Marley's Mutts Dog Rescue, Inc. is a California-based nonprofit social impact organization dedicated to the rescue, rehabilitation, and rehoming dogs while creating meaningful human connections through the power of the human and animal bond. Serving communities throughout Kern County and beyond, the organization provides life saving rescue efforts for at-risk dogs and operates innovative community programs that support a diverse population as well as animals.

Core programs include: Rescue, Rehabilitate and Rehome Program, the nationally recognized Pawsitive Change® Prison Program, Mutt Movers Transport Program and No-Cost Spay/Neuter Community Initiative.

With a strong focus on second chances, empathy, rehabilitation and community impact, Marley's Mutts works to improve outcomes for both vulnerable animals and the people whose lives are transformed by them.



COMMUNITY PROGRAMS

Rescue, Rehabilitate & Rehome Program Nestled on 20 beautiful acres in Tehachapi, California, the Marley's Mutts Rescue Ranch is a place where at-risk dogs are given the time, care and compassion they need to begin again. Each dog is treated as an individual, with the ultimate goal of preparing them for a loving, permanent home. At the Rescue Ranch, second chances aren't just something we believe in—they're what we create every day.



Pawsitive Change® A comprehensive 10/14 week rehabilitation & vocational training program that pairs dogs from high-kill shelters with incarcerated individuals for mutual rehabilitation. Training plans are created for individual dogs in basic obedience training. Graduates receive a Pawsitive Change Certificate of Completion and workforce re-entry skills.

No-Cost Spay/Neuter Community Initiative Benefits the underserved communities of Kern County to address the critical issue of pet overpopulation by providing free spay and neuter services to low-income dog owners.



Mutt Movers-No single rescue can help save every homeless dog in their community. Mutt Movers saves dogs from high-kill shelters and transports to rescue partners in other US States and Canada who have space and a shortage of adoptable dogs.

Superstar Ranch Volunteer

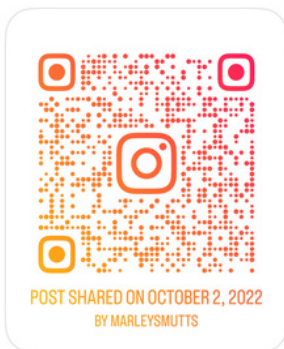
